Greetings from Admissions! Students and parents frequently indicate that meeting with faculty is pivotal in helping them to choose a college. With that in mind, I would like to sincerely thank you for volunteering your time to meet with our best and brightest students for **Fall 2015**. To make things a little easier, I have prepared an FAQ list which you will find below.

What does best and brightest really mean?

Each of the students in attendance will possess a minimum of a 3.6 GPA and 26 ACT or will be ranked 1st or 2nd in their high school class with a minimum 24 ACT.

Why are these students here?

Each of these students has already been awarded either the President's (full tuition) or the Founder's Scholarship (\$4000). They are coming here to sign their award letters and to interview for the Honors, Foundation Scholars, Cardinal Business Edge and/or Nursing Early Admission programs.

What are some examples of things that I should discuss with these students?

Ideally, you should talk about how our undergraduate focus and faculty interactions differentiate us from other programs. Examples include:

- Your bio and why you chose SVSU.
- Showcase laboratories, equipment or other hands-on opportunities.
- Examples of student research opportunities, study abroad programs, future graduate school opportunities.
- If you are in a room with access to the internet, you can walk students through the curriculum and discuss how it prepares them for the future.

What should I know about the scholarships?

In past years, students were coming to campus to interview for the President's Scholarship. That is no longer the case. The students that you will be meeting with have already been awarded either the President's (full tuition) or the new Founders' Scholarship (1/2 tuition) based on their high school GPA and composite ACT score.

Where do I need to be and when do I need to be there?

Enclosed in this packet is a roster of the students from your academic program. **Please report to Pioneer 245** and your students will be escorted to your location at **10:00:00 AM** and will need to leave for lunch around **10:50:00 AM**. Attached is a free lunch pass and we would love for you to join us. If you cannot, please use it at your convenience.
